QUESTIONS TO ASK:

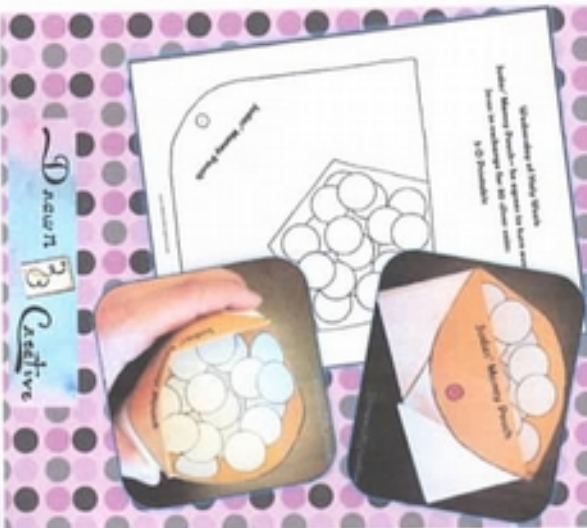
Who betrayed Jesus for money ? _____ Where did the soldiers find Jesus ? _____.

You could also make a garden in a meat or seed tray using sand/soil , plant cuttings , stones etc. Use lego figures to be Jesus and the disciples, Judas and the guards. Have fun !



40 Days of {Free} Lenten Printables Judas' Money Pouch



To make your Judas' Money Pouch follow these steps:

First print the printable on cardstock. Color it in and cut it out.

1



Fold it in half such that the two curved corners meet.

2



Fold the front flap down, using the black lines as a guide. The fold of the front flap should end right where the black lines run off the page. See the picture at

3



Fold the front flap back up.

4



Fold the side triangles inward such that the top corner is right where the top flap folds down, and the bottom edge lines up with the bottom of the money pouch. Secure with tape or glue dots.

Fold the top flap back down.

Remind your kids that all the money in the world is not worth giving up your love for Jesus! "For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world, and forfeit his soul?" Mark 8:36

Hang it from your mobile by hole punching the top and tying a string to it and the mobile.
